3.2 PROGRAMME ACTIVITY

Curriculum **(\$3000) August 2003**

3.2.1 National Summer School 2004

Stage 2004 National Summer School at Christchurch **(\$12,000) Jan 2004**
Plan and communicate arrangements for a national school for pipers, drummers to be held in Christchurch during January 2004 subject to sufficient enrolments.

3.2.2 National Band Leaders' Seminar

(\$4,000) Jan 2004
Plan and communicate arrangements for a National Band Leaders' Seminar for Pipe Majors, Pipe Sergeants and Drum Sergeants to be held in Christchurch during January 2004 subject to sufficient enrolments.

3.2.6 Scholarship Tuition

(\$3000) December 2003
Provide scholarship tuition for individual pipers and drummers who have demonstrated the potential to excel and benefit from expert tutelage, and for small groups of pipers and drummers who are preparing for College certificates.

3.2.7 Visiting Tutor

(\$4000) December 2003
Provide expert instruction to selected applicant bands which have the commitment and potential to benefit from a programme intended to develop their strategies for ongoing musical improvement.

3.2.8 Centre Education Programme Support
